India is rich in biodiversity and products known by its unique characters like the "Darjeeling Tea." Now most of the states are ahead with the registration of GIs from their states to get economic benefit out of such products. The increasing awareness about GIs can be used as a marketing tool and a potential source of additional revenue for most of the states in India.

Due to the fact that GIs are recognised, and not created; that they are linked to characteristics of a specific region, and that they are usually not reserved to a single producer. GIs offer interesting opportunities to particularly those parts of society that depend on agriculture, artisanal and craft work, or particular herbal products. As such, protection incentives could lead to the development of niche markets and small and medium-sized industries, specialising in the production and marketing of certain products. So far Indian registration history is not ambitious when compare with other countries in terms of registration and Part-B registration of beneficiaries.

It is important to train manpower in this area to increase the registration of Geographical Indications in India.
