## Training on "Safety and Health Management System Audit" (20<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2025)

**Coal Mines Regulation 2017** has provided for the preparation of a **Safety Management Plan** (SMP) based on Risk Assessment by the management, reviewing it periodically. The SMP contains ways to measure, monitor and evaluate the performance of the Safety and Health Management System of each mine and correct matters that do not conform to the SMP. The focus of the safety management system is system driven instead of individual-driven which is based on the principles of risk management instead of merely being compliance-oriented.

One of the reasons for the ineffective implementation of the present system of risk-based safety management in Indian coal mines is the lack of suitable mechanisms or processes for auditing the SMPs at regular intervals. In view of the above, **A SYSTEM OF REGULAR AUDITING** needs to be adopted by the mine management for effective implementation of the Safety and Health Management system. The auditing shall be done by qualified auditors who are experienced in SHMS having domain knowledge and experience.
