

#### INTRODUCE THE COURSE

Tamil, one of the world's oldest living classical languages, carries a rich linguistic, literary and cultural heritage that continues to thrive across centuries. This Certificate Course in Tamil Language is designed to introduce learners to the foundational elements of Tamil—from the alphabet and pronunciation to essential grammar, sentence patterns and spoken communication.

Through systematic instruction, this course guides learners in mastering Tamil letters (vowels, consonants, and their combinations), understanding the structure of nouns and verbs and applying fundamental grammar concepts such as cases, suffixes, pronouns, tense markers and conjunctions. The course also emphasises the distinction between formal (written) Tamil and informal (spoken) Tamil, enabling participants to use the language effectively in both academic and conversational contexts.

Each module combines theory with practical exercises, ensuring a balanced development of reading, writing, listening and speaking skills. By the end of this 8-week course, learners will be able to recognise and use Tamil script confidently, construct grammatically correct sentences, and engage in simple day-to-day conversations in Tamil.
