- b) Vision should be normal. In case of defective vision, it should be corrected to 6/9 in both eyes or 6/6 in the better eye. Colour blind or uniocular persons are ineligible for admission in Mining Engineering and Mining Machinery engeneering courses.
- c) Hearing should be normal. Defective hearing should be corrected.
- d) Heart and lungs should not have any abnormality and there should be no history of mental illness or epileptic fits.

I understand that, in case I am involved in ragging, the case will be reported to the police and the Law will take its own course and I will be summarily expelled from the institute.

However, I undertake to face disciplinary action / legal proceeding including expulsion from the institute if the above statement is found to be untrue or the facts are concealed, at any stage in future.

 - Mutilation or unauthorized possession of library books.
