




International Workshop on Rural Water Quality and Management (RWQM-2019)







INTRODUCTION

The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kharagpur and the University of Edinburgh are jointly organizing 3 days' workshop on Rural Water Quality and Management during 14th—16th May, 2019 at IIT Kharagpur. The workshop is fully funded by the University of Edinburgh through the Global Challenges Research Fund.

The workshop aims at creating a vibrant and productive platform for discussions on improving water quality and its efficient management in rural areas which is so crucial to promote socially inclusive development and wellbeing of rural households across the globe.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The workshop will stimulate new collaborative research projects in different aspects of water quality and management in rural areas, including areas such as water treatment, wastewater management, water contamination, diffused pollution, the water-food nexus, water and

ecosystems linkages, etc. along with role of local level institutions.

It will aim for attendance of around 30-40 participants, who will all be fully committed to the workshop during the three-days programme. The workshop is aimed at independent academic staff, along with selective inclusion of guests from industry, NGOs and other relevant organisations with 10-13 participants in each category of IITKharagpur academics, University of Edinburgh academics, and selected strategic guests from India and UK. Emphasis will be given for good gender, career-stage and disciplinary balance, with preference towards early-career academics.

We are open to applications from all relevant disciplines including engineering, geology, environmental science, chemistry, ecology, agricultural sciences, geography, political sciences, social sciences, business studies, economics, informatics/data, landscape design and architecture, cultural and behavioural studies, policy and governance, etc.



The workshop will focus on keynote talks, group activities, field visit and inter-disciplinary networking. The workshop will also discuss on possible funding opportunities for the proposed studies.

Emphasis will be given on inter-disciplinary projects in the area with scope for engagement of the govt. officials, NGOs, local level institutions and community based organisations.
