#### Introduction:

Gaining insights from different countries on these domains and analysis of the same with a transdisciplinary approach would facilitate capacity building and gainful research toward inclusive and sustainable development.

#### **About the Workshop:**

The Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur and The University of Edinburgh are jointly organizing five-day virtual student mobility programme during 24–28 May, 2021. The programme is fully funded by the University of Edinburgh. The proposed a virtual mobility programme focuses on developing the domain knowledge of the participants, particularly in Indian context, integrating ideas and expertise through group activities on the thematic areas and identifying the issues that these groups may continue working on in future. Emphasis will be given for good gender, career-stage and disciplinary balance in selection of participants. The programme is open to applications from all relevant disciplines including engineering, geology, environmental science, chemistry, agricultural sciences, geography, political sciences, social sciences, business studies, economics, informatics/data, landscape design and architecture, cultural and behavioural studies, policy and governance, etc.

#### Other Details of the Programme

Participation in the programme is strictly restricted to the undergraduate students of IIT Kharagpur and The University of Edinburgh only.

Participants [students of BTech. (Hons.), MTech. (Dual Degree), Integrated M.Sc., 2-Yr. M.Sc.] could be from any branches of engineering, geographical sciences, environmental sciences, bio-sciences, social sciences, economics, physical sciences, chemical sciences, management, etc.

The programme will comprise of recorded lectures, online demonstrations and interactions in a transdisciplinary framework along with joint project works by the students of IIT Kharagpur and The University of Edinburgh under the mentorship of faculty members from both the institutes
