**Subject: Platinum Jubilee International Symposiums** 

Fourteen Platinum Jubilee International Symposiums/Conferences have been planned as part of the Institute's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations (details attached). In this regard, the following are proposed:

- 1. The names for all fourteen symposiums will adhere to the following format "IIT Kharagpur Platinum Jubilee International Symposium (Conference) on....."
- 2. The Institute shall grant seed money of up to Rs. 25 lakhs for each symposium, provided this amount is less than 75% of the total budget for the symposium. Otherwise, the seed money granted for each symposium will be equal to 75% of the total budget for the symposium.
- An umbrella project shall be opened in CEP under the heading "Platinum Jubilee International Symposiums". Under the umbrella project, subprojects will be opened for individual symposiums.
- 4. The lead convener of each symposium will initiate a request for opening the subproject for his/her symposium after providing the necessary details in a form created for the purpose. The request will need to be endorsed by the Convener of the Academic Events Subcommittee of the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations Committee.
- 5. After the subproject for a symposium has been opened, 50% of the seed money for the symposium will be made available in the CEP account for the symposium. The remaining 50% of the seed money will be disbursed 3 months before the planned date of the symposium.
- 6. All funds collected from sponsorships/registration fees will be deposited in the CEP account for the symposium.
- 7. The Continuing Education Office will be requested to not charge overhead on the seed money for the Platinum Jubilee International Symposiums. Any additional sums collected as registration fees or as sponsorship from external agencies will be subject to the usual overhead charges.
