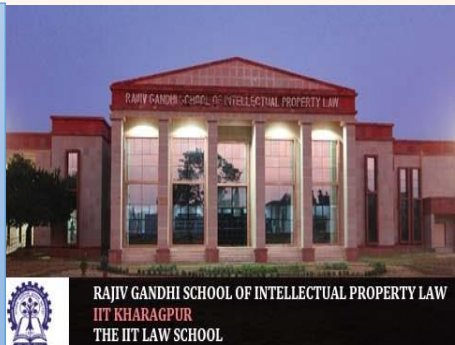

According to World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO), intellectual property (IP) is the creation of mind such as inventions, literary and artistic works, and symbols, names, images, and designs used in commerce. IP, as a key intellectual asset of an organization, empowers the organization to collect the complete value of their intellectual input. It is not just IP generation that helps in growth and development, but its efficient management determines its role for wealth creation and well-being of the society. In this era of rapidly changing IP regimes, it is the need of time to identify and efficiently utilize intellectual assets owned by an organization. IP management (IPM) is a multifaceted discipline concerned with IP generation, protection, and exploitation catering to fast changing market demands across the globe. IPM of academic institutes in India is a big challenge. Although, there is availability of huge intellectual capital and enough resources to develop a new process or products, lack of availability of enough IP experts affects IP generation and commercialization. This course is designed considering these above-mentioned facts. This course will touch base upon various IPM related processes (100 + IPM related processes) required for IPR cell development and its self-management.
