The Twenty Eighth National Symposium on Cryogenics and Superconductivity (NSCS28) will be hosted by Cryogenic Engineering Centre, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kharagpur under the aegis of the Indian Cryogenics Council (ICC), at IIT Kharagpur Campus during October 18 – 21, 2022.

NSCS is a biennial event organised by ICC. The last symposium was held at IIT Mumbai in 2019. NSCS facilitates interactions among both the budding and expert researchers, scientists, and technologists from national and international fora in the field of cryogenics and superconductivity.
