

**Subject: Security Advisory for Kali Puja/ Diwali /Illumination
Programme – 2018**

In view of Kali Puja/ Diwali/ Illumination Programmes which will be held on 06th & 07th Nov. 2018, the under mentioned Security Advisory shall be followed:

For Kali Puja:

- 1. Visitors / Devotees entry shall be allowed from all Gates of campus (i.e Puri gate/ Prembazar Gate/ Durga Mandir gate) except Gas Go-down gate/Chandi Mandir gate between 11 p.m. to 06 a.m. on 06/11/2018 only.*
- 2. Parking will not be allowed in and around of the Puja Mandap (s). Residents /Visitor's may use only designated parking places for parking of their vehicles.*
- 3. Sufficient volunteers shall be engaged by respective Puja committees to take care of Puja Darshan movement especially in evening hours.*
- 4. All gates of Campus will be operated for whole night on 06th Nov 2018 for Devotees/ Visitors, except Gas Go-down gate/ Chandi Mandir gate.*
- 5. All Puja committee are requested to maintain cleanliness in and around of the Puja mandap during Puja celebration.*
- 6. Puja organizers will play the PA/ Sound system within permissible limit as directed by Police / Law.*

For Illumination Programme:-

- 1. During Illumination programme on 7th Nov 2018, no motorized vehicles/ bi-cycles will be allowed on Scholars Avenue and surrounding Halls area between 05 p.m. to 10 p.m. except of Illumination/ Rangoli Judge's Convoy.*
- 2. There will be placement of Iron Road Barriers at different location for Traffic / Parking management during Illumination Programme to be held on 07th Nov 2018 between 05 p.m. to 10 p.m. organized by Technology Student Gymkhana.*
- 3. All main road street lights will remain on during Illumination/ Rangoli Programme, like normal days except between R P Hall to R K Hall road (between 7:45 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.). However, inside the Hall premises light can be put off as per the choices of respective Hall Illumination/ Rangoli organizing team.*
- 4. Each Hall should have the provision for spectator's gallery inside the Hall premises, where spectators can stand and watch the illumination programme without disturbing/ blocking the entry/ exit movement of Judges Vehicles Convoy.*
- 5. Fire extinguishers (ABC & CO2 types) will be placed in all Hall Security Kiosks to tackle any fire emergency.*
- 6. Respective Halls will arrange buckets filled with sands and keep handy at Security Kiosk.*
- 7. Respective Halls will depute some volunteers (student and hall staff) to help Security Personnel in tackling any fire emergency.*
- 8. Respective Halls will arrange First-aid Box and keep in Security Kiosk.*

8. After 10 p.m. no male students/ visitors will be allowed inside the Girls Hall of Residences.

9. Stand-by Fire Tender (WBF&S) and Ambulance will be available at TSG.

General Points

1. There will random checking of the commuters who will visit IIT campus during Kali Puja/ Illumination programme days.

2. Outsider vehicles movement especially in Residential/ Hostels area will be strictly monitored.

3. Whole IIT Campus will be under strict surveillance of security / police during the Puja holidays.

4. Rash driving/ Eve teasing/ Over speeding/ Violation of campus security rules will be strictly dealt by Security/ Police.
